Tammy Buffington discussed the proposed interlocal agreement between the City of Benkelman and Dundy County for the County C&D Dump site.

Motion by Richard to approve the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement, seconded by Keiser.

Ayes: Unanimous

Contacted Steve of Pristine Clean for a proposal to clean the County Courthouse and Annex, will contact later in meeting when he is back in the office.

Opened a proposal from Sue Nelms to clean the county courthouse.

Vince Turpin and Mary Deyle arrived to discuss the county credit cards. Turpin had concerns of individuals associated with the county cards and what information of theirs would be involved in what processes. Deyle explained that Dundy County would be ultimately responsible for the expenditures of the credit cards, not the individuals.

Commissioners and Sheriff Smith discussed the letter received from NLETC regarding the sheriff's eligibility to attend training at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center. A conference call was conducted with Brenda Urbanek, Director of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center. Urbanek

explained that Smith did not meet the physical standards to attend the May 1st NLETC Training. Urbanek explained that Smith could go before the Police Standards Advisory Council on May 17th to seek an extension to be able to attend a later NLETC training session to meet qualifications. If an extension would be granted, all admission standards would need to be met to attend the next course that begins in late August, and the 8 month statutory deadline to become certified would also be extended.

Sheriff Smith presented the Sheriff's monthly report.

Discussion to transfer monies from the State 911 Fund (2913) to the County General Fund for the cost of a 911 Console paid in 2022 approved by the Nebraska Public Service Commission.

Motion by Keiser to approve Resolution 76-2023-7 to transfer \$69,511.20 from the State 911 Fund (2913) to the County General Fund, seconded by Olson.

Ayes: Unanimous

Pam Reichert discussed the county Communication Center. Discussed planned infrastructure changes to the dispatch center.

Arlan Wine delivered the county Attorney's report. County handbook still in process. County time-clock

Motion by Keiser to approve Sue Nelms' proposed contract, proposal 1, to clean the County bathrooms for a cost of \$10/bathroom, for a total of \$70.00 once a week, for a period of 1 year, seconded by Richard.

Reviewed email proposal from Pristine Clean to clean county courthouse and annex.

Motion by Keiser to approve the proposal as submitted by Pristine Clean for cleaning the Dundy County Courthouse and county office annex building, for \$175.00 per week, seconded by Richard.

Ayes: Unanimous

Spoke to Steve of Pristine Clean and informed them that their proposal was accepted, will be starting Saturday April 22nd.

Spoke to Jake of Elite Diesel of Cheyenne, WY about working on the county Mack truck.

With no further business, Chairman Olson adjourned the meeting at 10:49 A.M. The next regular meeting of the Dundy County Commissioners will be held on April 17th, 2023 at 8:30 a.m.
